1. INTRODUCTION

The 2001 Goodwill Games is the most prestigious sporting event on the 2001 sporting calendar. The Games will be held in Brisbane from 29 August to 9 September 2001. Over the 12 days of competition, a field of around 1300 of the world's best athletes will be invited to compete in 14 adrenalin-pumping sports. These sports are:

Athletics; Basketball; Beach Volleyball; Boxing; Diving; Figure Skating; Artistic Gymnastics; Rhythm Gymnastics; Swimming; Surf Lifesaving; Track Cycling; Trampoline; Triathlon; and Weightlifting.

Athletes will be invited to compete in a unique finals-only format. However, team competition sports will involve qualifying rounds. Such a format ensures an atmosphere of unparalleled excitement and spectacular sporting action.

Invitations to compete will be sent to individual athletes and teams based on their current world ranking, their performance at their most recent world championship, Olympic performance and past Goodwill Games performance. Athletes compete for medals and prize money totalling \$10 million AUD. In addition, there are bonuses on offer for world record breaking performances.

Organisation of the 2001 Goodwill Games is a joint venture between Goodwill Games Inc., based in Atlanta, USA, and a local organising company - 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited.

The international television broadcasting rights for the event are held by host broadcaster Turner Network Television (TNT) and the rights for broadcast within Australia are held by Nine Network Australia.

To participate in the 2001 Goodwill Games, *all* media will need to be registered through an accreditation process. To gain accreditation, each media organisation will need to complete and return an application form for each person requiring accreditation to 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by the required deadline. Goodwill Games Inc. and 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited are solely responsible for determining which organisations and individuals will receive accreditation.

The deadline for media accreditation applications is 15 May 2001. By reading this manual, media will be able to complete and return their application and learn more about media facilities at the 2001 Goodwill Games.

2. HOW TO GET ACCREDITED

2.1. Background to Our Media Accreditation Process

- ?? The 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited is preparing for a maximum of 350 individual media representatives to be accredited to cover the Games.
- ?? ALL MEDIA planning to cover the Games need to register for accreditation using the forms sent out with this manual.
- ?? Media organisations must register BY NAME each of their staff members requiring accreditation for the Games.
- ?? All original Accreditation Applications must be returned to 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by **15 May 2001**. Applications which have not been received by 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by the required deadline may not be processed.

2.2. The Process

The 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited has designed a Media Accreditation Process that is simple, transparent and fair. For ease of understanding, the process has been divided into six (6) steps.

Step 1 – 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited Sets Media Accreditation Limit

This stage has been completed. A total of 350 places are available for media representatives at the 2001 Goodwill Games. This number was arrived at following research into previous Goodwill Games and venue capacities in Brisbane. A Media Accreditation Survey was also carried out earlier this year to assess media interest in the Games, expected accreditation numbers and media equipment requirements.

The 350-place limit will help ensure that:

- a) 2001 Goodwill Games media staff can maintain an appropriate level of service to media;
- b) Accredited media have adequate access to resources; and
- c) Overcrowding does not occur in media work areas.

Step 2 – Distribution of Media Accreditation Application Forms

This step is the stage the accreditation process is now in. Accreditation Manuals, which include application forms and other information about the 2001 Goodwill Games, have been sent to Australian and international media.

Step 3 – Complete and Return Media Accreditation Application Forms

Media accreditation application forms sent out with this manual need to be:

- a) Returned to 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by **15 May 2001**.
- b) Written in English.
- c) Completed in pen only, in printed capital (upper case) letters and signed by each applicant.
- d) Returned with two identical photographs of each person requiring accreditation.

Important! Media organisations requiring accreditation for more than one staff member must fill out individual forms for EACH applicant. For ease of processing, these forms should be sent in together. A cover sheet entitled “*Multiple Accreditation Application*” has been provided for organisations sending in more than one application. This cover sheet should be completed and attached to the top of the bundle containing all of the individual applications from the one media organisation. Applications not received by 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by **15 May 2001** may not be processed. Each application must include two photographs of the person requiring accreditation.

Step 3a. Completing the Form – Field by Field

1. Personal Details

The applicant’s title, first and last names, preferred name, date of birth, gender, passport number, nationality, media organisation, name and contact details for editor / chief of staff should be entered into the relevant boxes.

2. Media Category

Please select the appropriate category, choosing one box only.

3. Games Role

Select the box corresponding with your occupation, choosing one box only.

4. General Information

Please provide details of additional information that needs to be included in your application for media accreditation, including any physical limitations that may require special accommodation at the Press centres.

5. Terms and Conditions of Accreditation Waiver

All accreditation application forms **MUST** include the signature of the applicant. By signing the application form, the applicant agrees to the terms and conditions outlined in this manual and to the terms and conditions of use of the Media Accreditation Pass during Games time.

Step 3b. Application Deadline

All **original** Accreditation Applications must be received by 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by **15 May 2001**. Faxed and e-mail copies can be sent, but originals must be received by 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by 15 May 2001. Applications which have not been received by 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited by the required deadline may not be processed.

Should any changes or cancellations occur after applications have been lodged, please notify 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited in writing immediately.

Important! Sending your accreditation application in on time will ensure you are eligible for rapid accreditation validation at Games time, which will dramatically reduce your waiting time for your accreditation to be activated.

Step 4 – Photographs

To gain media accreditation for the 2001 Goodwill Games, **two identical photographs** must accompany each application. The photographs **must** comply with the following regulations:

- a) The photographs should be an accurate likeness of the applicant
- b) The photos must be colour originals
- c) The size of the photographs must be 45mm x 35mm – 1 ¾" x 1 3/8 " (standard Passport size)
- d) The photographs should be a front view of the applicant's head and shoulders
- e) Hats, hair bands or dark sunglasses may not be worn, unless always worn for religious reasons
- f) The background must be plain
- g) The photographs must not have been altered in any way
- h) The name of the applicant must be written on the back of **both** photographs

Step 5 – Confirmation of Media Accreditation Applications

Following the application deadline, 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited will process all of the applications received.

All applicants will be notified by mail whether or not they have been successful in gaining media accreditation. For successful applicants, a report will be sent confirming accreditation, along with any additional information which may need to be communicated. Successful applicants will also be required to verify the information which has been provided to 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited. If any of the information contained in the report is incorrect, applicants are advised to contact 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited immediately so that inaccuracies can be corrected.

Step 6 – Collecting Media Accreditation Pass

A 2001 Goodwill Games Media Accreditation Pass is the official Games Accreditation Pass and provides the bearer with access to designated Games venues. Media Accreditation Passes will be prepared for all approved applicants.

Media Accreditation Passes for approved applicants will be available for collection after **1 August 2001** from the Main Accreditation Centre located at:

Photo Identification must be presented to 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited accreditation staff before a media accreditation pass is issued.

2.3 - Entry and Immigration Requirements

International media travelling to Australia to cover the 2001 Goodwill Games will need to make their own entry and immigration arrangements. The Department of Immigration and Multicultural Affairs (DIMA) deal with all applications for entry into Australia.

2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited recommends visiting DIMA's website at www.immi.gov.au for further information. However, to make this process easy to understand, 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited has outlined below some basic information regarding entry requirements into Australia.

Please Note! This information is a guide only and all international media should contact their nearest Australian Mission.

Visa Requirements

Australia's migration laws require that every non-Australian travelling to Australia must obtain a visa to enter. Depending on nationality, persons entering Australia will be required to obtain a visa in one of two ways:

- a) Electronically – known as an ETA (Electronic Travel Authority); or
- b) Label – a passport stamp that requires the participant to present a passport to one of the many world-wide Australian missions.

ETA (Electronic Travel Authority)

This system allows a person's travel (tourists and short-term business travellers) to Australia to be authorised in seconds through their travel agent's computer link to an international network. Some key points concerning ETAs are:

- ?? No written application is required and no visa label or stamp is inserted into the passport.
- ?? Participating airlines' check-in terminals are linked with the system to allow the airline to confirm that the passenger has an ETA for travel to Australia.
- ?? ETAs are available to passport holders from 31 countries. These are:

- ?? Media accredited to cover the 2001 Goodwill Games will need to apply for a Business ETA.

Label

Accredited media from countries not listed above need to apply for a Business Visitor Visa. To apply for this Visa media need to fill out a copy of Form 456. This form can be downloaded from DIMA's Internet site, www.immi.gov.au, or obtained from the nearest Australian Mission. There is an application charge of \$60 (AUD) for this Visa.

¹ Some conditions apply

Important! International media travelling to Australia to cover the 2001 Goodwill Games will need to make their own entry and immigration arrangements. **ALL** non-Australians will require a visa to enter the country and it is their own responsibility to ensure they obtain an entry visa prior to departure. Visas should be applied for as early as possible. It is recommended that applicants lodge their visa applications 6-8 weeks in advance of the event to ensure that it will be processed in time.

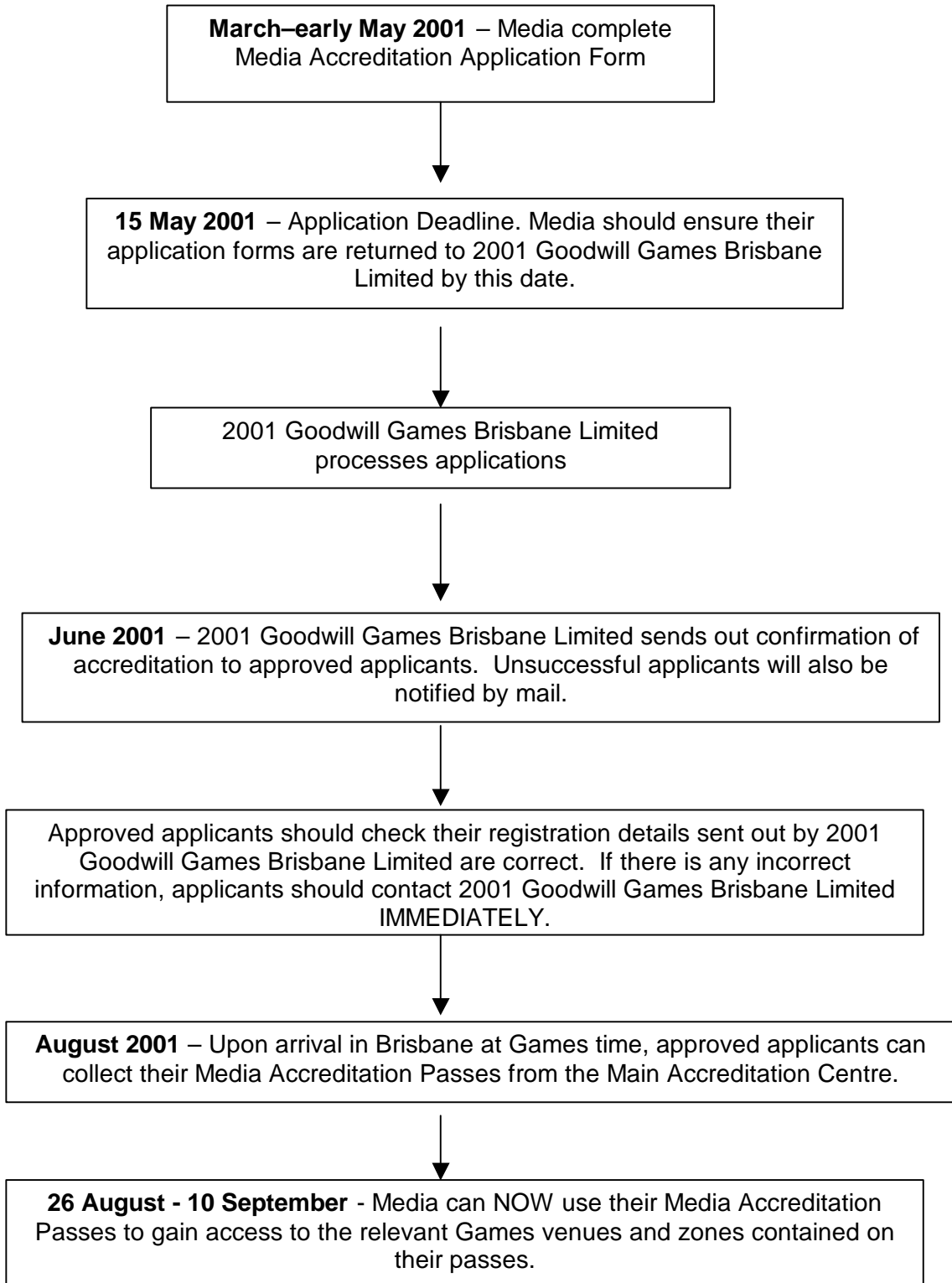
2.4 – Lost or Damaged Cards

If a Media Accreditation Pass is lost or damaged, the cardholder can apply for a new pass at the Main Accreditation Centre located at:

Important! Photographic identification will be required to obtain a new Media Accreditation Pass. Any request for a replacement media accreditation will also require verification from the applicant's media organisation. This could be a lengthy process, so it is important that copies of original photos sent in with the application are brought to Brisbane to make this process quicker and easier for all involved. Replacement of an accreditation pass may incur a fee.

3. TYPES OF ACCREDITATION

3.1 Background

The media accreditation process allows 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited to monitor access to all 2001 Goodwill Games venues. All media approved for accreditation at the 2001 Goodwill Games will have access to the Main Press Centre and Venue Press Centres, including press conferences. However, access to venue seating and tribunes allocated for media use will be restricted due to space limitations and so, therefore, will be ticketed. The media ticketing process is outlined in section 3.4 of this manual.

3.2 Types of Media Accreditation

There are five categories of accreditation for media at the 2001 Goodwill Games. These categories are:

1. **Television – Rights Holders:** For the 2001 Goodwill Games, Turner Network Television (TNT) holds the international broadcast rights and the Nine Network Australia holds the Australian broadcast rights. These two organisations are the *only* television rights holders for the 2001 Goodwill Games.
2. **Television – Non-Rights Holders:** This category includes television media representatives from organisations other than rights holders.
3. **Radio** – All radio media are included in this category.
4. **Print Media** – This category includes media representatives from newspapers, magazines and online publications.

<p>Special Note! All photographs can only be used for editorial purposes and representatives from online publications are only allowed to use still photographic equipment.</p>

5. **Freelance** – This category includes freelance journalists and photographers. For a freelance media accreditation pass to be issued, the applicant must provide a 'Letter of Assignment' from a media organisation.

Within these five categories, working media will be categorised as a journalist, photographer or camera operator / technician.

3.3 Requirements For Non-Rights Holding Media

There are strict guidelines governing the activities of media organisations that do not hold official rights to broadcast the 2001 Goodwill Games. These guidelines are outlined below.

Turner Sports, Inc. and its affiliated entity, Goodwill Games, Inc. (collectively, "Turner Sports") own the exclusive television, internet and radio rights throughout the World, on both a live and delayed basis, to the 2001 Goodwill Games, scheduled for August 29 -September 9, 2001, in and around Brisbane, Queensland, Australia (the "Games"). Those rights, under agreement with Turner Sports, Inc, extend to the Nine Network and AusteroNetwork in the host country of Australia as Goodwill games partners. These rights and this exclusivity extends to all athletic competitions and related events of the Games, including without limitation, all sporting competitions and exhibitions, the opening celebration, awards and other official ceremonies, and all other events and performances within Games venues

conducted by or on behalf of Turner Sports either at the Games' sites or in other areas controlled by or on behalf of Turner Sports (the "Games Material").

There can be no broadcast, cablecast or other exhibition any portions of the Games Material in any form of television (including, without limitation, over-the-air broadcast, DBS, MDS, pay television, subscription television, cable television and superstation telecast), internet, broadband, radio or any other medium (all of such forms of broadcast, cablecast or exhibition shall be referred to herein collectively as a "telecast") whatsoever by any entity or individual within the United States, its territories and possessions, and the host country Australia (the "Territory"), other than by Turner Sports, except as described herein or otherwise with the execution of separate license agreement with Turner Sports.

Notwithstanding such exclusivity, Turner Sports has agreed to permit news access by broadcasters and cablecasters (referred to herein collectively as the "telecasters" and individually as the "telecaster") of excerpts of the Games Material (the "excerpts") from Turner Sports' television coverage of the Games within the Territory, but only in accordance with the following restrictions:

1. No excerpts, irrespective of their source, may be shown outside the Territory without the express written consent of Turner Sports.
2. Excerpts may be used only in regularly scheduled news programs of which actual news elements constitute the main feature. This excludes programming such as news magazines, news or sports features, sports magazines, or other sports programming. In the case of an all-sports network, excerpts may be used only as part of regularly scheduled news, wrap-up or update programs and is subject to the limitations contained herein.
3. The use of excerpts in any one news program cannot exceed three (3) minutes in the aggregate.
4. Only excerpts which already have been telecast by Nine Network in Australia, or TNT in the United States, may be used, provided this excerpts of footage are not broadcast within 15 minutes of their being telecast by either Nine Network or TNT on the same event day it was aired.
5. Excerpts may be used only until September 16, 2001. Any further use of excerpts in any manner, from any source, following September 16, 2001 will require the prior written approval of Turner Sports.
6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary which may be contained herein, no use may be made at any time of the voices and/or likenesses of any of the on-air talent, commentators and/or announcers of Turner Sports.
7. In each instance of a use by a telecaster of any excerpts, a minimum five-seconds supered video credit over footage must be given to "Courtesy TNT Sports". Within Australia that five-second courtesy would read "Courtesy Nine Network". Pursuant to relevant copyright law, TNT plans to record on videotape their programming of the Games simultaneously with the transmission thereof. The copyright owner of the programming and the resulting recorded audiovisual work will be Turner Sports, and all efforts will be made to secure copyright of this material following its fixation.

Turner Sports will take every step necessary to ensure that its exclusivity with respect to the cablecast and broadcast of the Games and any Games Material therefrom is respected. Any use of any excerpts or portions of Games Material other than as expressly provided herein at any time including any use of any Games Material after September 16, 2001 irrespective of

its source, would be considered a serious violation of the rights of Turner Sports and would subject any such user to a charge of copyright infringement and related legal and equitable remedies. Furthermore, as the exclusive telecast rights to the Games in areas other than the Territory are held either jointly or severally by Turner Sports and other territorial licensees, the unauthorized use of the Games Material in any such areas would subject such user to similar charges and remedies.

In addition, please be advised that Turner Sports has acquired a number of original music compositions which are under exclusive license to Turner Sports for commercial and promotional uses in television. It is not permissible to use any of these compositions in any commercial, promotional or thematic manner whatsoever, since to do so would violate our exclusive rights. All telecasters are required to obtain any music performing rights licenses which may be necessary for the use of music within any excerpted Games Material.

If your news organization desires to originate programming from any of the Games venues during the Games, you should obtain accreditation and reserve space by contacting Jeff Pomeroy, Director, Public Relations, Goodwill Games Inc., at (404) 827-4786 or Neville Conway at 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited at (011) 61-7-3233-2161 in Australia. Any origination of actual competition footage from such presence at any Games venue is strictly prohibited.

For your information, the Games competition schedule is attached. We reserve the right at any time and at our sole discretion to withdraw or modify the permission herein granted.

Your attention to and cooperation with all of the foregoing will be greatly appreciated.

3.4 Media Ticketing

While 2001 Goodwill Games has striven to provide ample media seating and work areas at all press centres, space constraints at some venues will require seating to be ticketed for the media.

To gain a seat at a venue which has limited seating, accredited media will need to apply 48 hours before an event at the News / Information Desk at the Main Press Centre. Tickets will be available for collection 24 hours prior to the event from the News / Information Desk at the Main Press Centre.

It is the sole discretion of 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited and Goodwill Games Inc. as to the allocation of ticketed media seats.

4. GAMES TIME PRESS CENTRES

4.1. Main Press Centre

The Main Press Centre for the 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited will be located at P6 at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre (BCEC). A total of six sports will be hosted at the BCEC and a further two sports will be held at the nearby South Bank precinct.

The sports being held at the BCEC and South Bank precinct are listed below:

The Main Press Centre workroom will provide seating space for 170 accredited media. In addition, 250 seats will be available in the Main Press Centre's press conference area.

Other facilities that will be available to accredited media on a shared basis at the Main Press Centre include:

- ?? Photographic development facilities;
- ?? Photocopiers;
- ?? Facsimiles (user pays);
- ?? Desktop Computers (some of which will have Internet access);
- ?? Printers;
- ?? Telstra Desktop Payphones; and
- ?? Lockable space.

Media organisations also have the chance to rent lockable office space in the Main Press Centre. Since this space is limited, allocation will be at the discretion of 2001 Goodwill Games Brisbane Limited.

If lockable office space is required, please indicate this on the Media Accreditation Application form. Arrangements for media organisations that are successful in securing lockable office space will be made at a later date.

The Main Press Centre will commence operations on Sunday, August 26. It will be open between the hours of 9am and 2am for the duration of the 2001 Goodwill Games. The exception will be Sunday, September 2 when the Main Press Centre will open at 7am to accommodate media prior to the Triathlon event.

4.2 Venue Press Centres

In addition to the Main Press Centre, Venue Press Centres will be located at the remaining sports venues for the 2001 Goodwill Games. These sports and venues are listed in the table below.
